

Attention Senior Class of 2017!



It's time to schedule an appointment for your senior portrait. <u>Please show this letter to your parents and definitely bring this to your photographer at the time of your appointment</u>, especially if you are going to a studio outside the Appleton area. With all the photographers and photo possibilities out there, there is need to set some specifications for your yearbook headshot.

- 1. All senior portraits must be turned in by mid-October, with OCTOBER 28th, 2016 as the absolute deadline. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 2. Photos may be submitted to Ms. Abbie O'Toole via email at Appletoneastyearbook@aasd.k12.wi.us or otooleabbie@aasd.k12.wi.us
- 3. **Digital copies are required**—the best way to do this is to have your photographer send in your selected photo. If you only have access to a print copy of the photo, it must be scanned and emailed in or a photo CD can be mailed or turned into the business office:

- 4. We reserve the right to reject or recrop photos that do not meet the requirements listed below:
 - Photos should be at least a standard wallet size with a measurement from eyebrow to chin of ¾"
 - The picture must be a standard portrait, head and shoulders <u>ONLY</u>, no hands or raised arms in the frame
 - <u>Vertical pose</u>, not horizontal
 - Photos must be in <u>full color</u>; no black and white, sepia, or loud filters
 - Aim for a neutral background; outdoor shots are acceptable as long as the background is not distracting or bold
 - <u>Attire must follow the school dress code</u> no hats, no spaghetti straps or strapless tops, crop tops, shirts with alcohol or drug references, etc. See your student handbook for reference.
 - No props allowed; friends, pets, outside poses with cars/weapons, or backgrounds that are distasteful/loudly colored etc.
- 5. If you do not have your portrait in by <u>October 28th, 2016 your photo will NOT BE IN THE YEARBOOK! NO EXCEPTIONS.</u>
 Technical issues will NOT be taken into consideration as an excuse for missing the deadline.
- 6. If you do not submit a photo on time, your photo ID will be used instead—if you take a "silly senior" picture for your ID then you will be listed as "Not Pictured".
- 7. Start making your portrait appointments now and do not wait until the last minute. Remember that it takes several weeks for the studio to process the photos.
