

Guidelines for Outagamie County Retired Educators Association Scholarship

In Spring of 2022, the OCREA will awarding one - \$500 scholarship to a High School senior in Outagamie County who wishes to enter the field of education.

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a resident of Outagamie County in Wisconsin
2. Be a senior in one of Outagamie County's Public High Schools
3. Be interested in pursuing the field of education as a degree teacher at an accredited college or university.

Applicant must submit the following information in order to be considered for the OCREA Scholarship:

1. A resume which includes the following: Name, address, parent(s), phone number, email address, high school, class standing, cumulative G.P.A., and name of college he/she will be attending.
2. Additional information, which will be beneficial: Academic Honors, other activities (school), and other activities (community).
3. We ask that the applicant submit a paragraph or two indicating why they wish to enter the field of education, and how this scholarship would contribute to his/her educational growth.
4. We ask that a letter of reference from a current or former teacher be submitted as a part of the application information as well.

The completed scholarship application must be sent to the following address by March 1, 2022. Those participating will be notified as to the results by April 1, 2022 – the recipient of the award as well as other applicants.
