# WHERE CAN I WORK?

Transportation, distribution and logistics is a critical sector of the U.S. economy. Technology will continue to streamline and transform the logistics and distribution industry. Employment in the automotive repair sector is expected to increase due to the sophistication and dependency on electronic controls and systems in motor vehicles requiring skilled professionals to perform repair and maintenance services.

This career cluster prepares students for careers in transportation, distribution and logistics that involve planning, managing the movement of materials as well as related professional and technical support services such as mobile equipment and facility maintenance.

Students in transportation, distribution and logistics learn and practice skills that prepare them for diverse post-secondary opportunities. These opportunities could include two or four-year college programs, apprenticeships or employment. The Youth Apprenticeship Program in collaboration with Career and Technical Education courses will introduce you to a variety of interesting careers.
